ARTICLET

AMENDMENTS to the ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

This organization is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, Creston Alumni Association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

Upon the dissolution of this Association, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) on the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code), or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Association is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

These amendments to the Articles of Association of the Creston Alumni Association are adopted on December 16, 1996.
